## The Public Warehousing and Storage course focuses on five areas:

- **Powered Industrial Trucks** – recommended practices for maneuvering, servicing, traveling, and loading – also basic principles for load composition, balance, stability, surface conditions, pedestrians, narrow aisles, ramps and ventilation.
- **Materials Handling** – identify hazards associated with handling materials including ergonomics, proper lifting techniques, storage, transport techniques, packaging and work practices.
- **Hazard Communications** – Identify purpose of Hazard Communication Standard, describe employer and employee rights and responsibilities, container labeling requirements, information required on MSDS
- **Exit Routes, Emergency Action and Fire Prevention Plans** – discuss components of an exit route, an emergency action plan, purpose of fire prevention plans and various types of fire extinguishers and their intended use.
- **Guarding Floor and Wall Openings** – understand the general requirements for working and walking surfaces, procedures for guarding floor and wall openings, methods for guarding employees working on loading docks, methods for safely guarding stairways and ladders.



The course is designed as a training course for warehouse workers and will focus on many hazards and injuries that are likely to be encountered in warehouse operations. It has been shown that warehousing has become an increasingly hazardous area to work in. OSHA has identified Public Storage and Warehousing as one of seven industries with a high lost time claims rate. Injuries may occur from forklifts; material handling and lifting; exposure to hazardous substances; and slips, trips and falls. The course will discuss: powered industrial trucks; material handling/lifting/ergonomics; hazard communication; walking and working surfaces; and exit routes and fire protection.
