



How to Earn Construction and General Industry Certificates:

- 1) Participants need to **complete a total of seven courses**, comprised of **three required courses** and **four elective courses** for a **minimum total of 68 contact hours**. All required and elective courses are listed below.
- 2) Courses taken at different OTI Education Centers are transferable and can count towards the certificate program.
- 3) Once training requirements are completed, fill out the application found on the MAOTIEC Website - www.oshamidatlantic.org. When you submit your application, a \$95 processing fee is required.
